FEES

There is a semi-annual registration and insurance fee of \$15.00 per family.

All tuition is due on the 1st of the month, and is late on the 6th of the month. A late fee of \$15.00 will be due if tuition is paid after the 5th of the month. If tuition is not received by the 10th of the month, the student will not be allowed to participate in classes until all fees due are paid in full.

To The Pointe is a year-round school. Full tuition is due every month regardless of holidays, vacations, or missed classes. Partial monthly payments or pro-rated payments are not accepted for registered students for any reason. Tuition cannot be carried to successive months.

Returned, voided or NSF checks will be charged \$25.00

Private lessons are to be scheduled and paid for in advance of the lesson (\$50 / hr).

ENROLLMENT

New student registration is currently being accepted throughout the month and students may register at any time. For enrollment from the 1st through the 15th of the month, full tuition will be charged. For enrollment from the 16th to the end of the month, tuition will be discounted one half.

Students ages 7 and up with no prior dance experience will be placed in Ballet IB to begin, with advancement opportunities in both Sept. and March. Students with prior dance experience will need to attend a placement class based upon their age and prior years of dancing. After the class, the student will be placed in a level deemed appropriate for their technical capabilities. In general, students can expect to spend 1 year per level.

Placement classes and classes taken by the student to determine if the school is where they would like to study are charged the \$15 Drop-in rate. If the student then registers for classes, the Drop-in Fee will be applied to the Registration Fee.
